

HUME AND HOVELL TRACK CLOSURES

BUSHFIRES HAVE BURNT THROUGH APPROXIMATELY 120KM OF THE HUME AND HOVELL TRACK DURING JANUARY 2020. SUBSEQUENT HEAVY RAINS HAVE CAUSED ADDITIONAL DAMAGE TO THE TRACK SURFACE AND SOME INFRASTRUCTURE.

AS A RESULT, APPROXIMATELY 60KM OF THE HUME AND HOVELL TRACK IS CLOSED BETWEEN BLOWING CAMPSITE (SOUTH OF TUMUT) AND HENRY ANGEL TRACKHEAD NEAR TUMBARUMBA.


THE COL DANIEL BRIDGE WHICH IS LOCATED ON TUMBARUMBA CREEK HAS RECENTLY BEEN DESTROYED BY FLOOD. WHILE THE TRACK IS STILL OPEN ON BOTH SIDES OF THE BRIDGE, **THIS CROSSING IS DANGEROUS AND SHOULD NOT BE ATTEMPTED.**

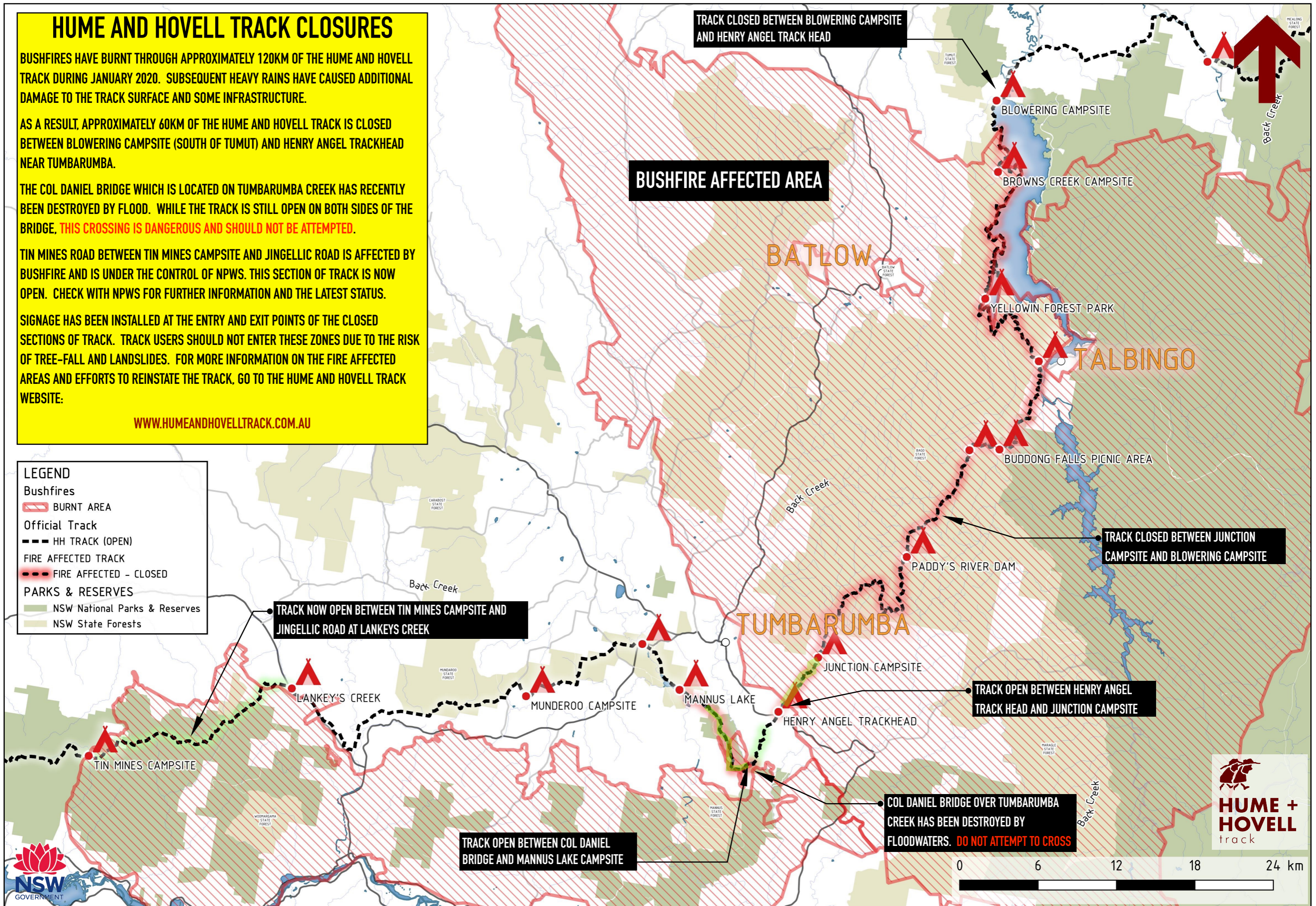
TIN MINES ROAD BETWEEN TIN MINES CAMPSITE AND JINGELIC ROAD IS AFFECTED BY BUSHFIRE AND IS UNDER THE CONTROL OF NPWS. THIS SECTION OF TRACK IS NOW OPEN. CHECK WITH NPWS FOR FURTHER INFORMATION AND THE LATEST STATUS.

SIGNAGE HAS BEEN INSTALLED AT THE ENTRY AND EXIT POINTS OF THE CLOSED SECTIONS OF TRACK. TRACK USERS SHOULD NOT ENTER THESE ZONES DUE TO THE RISK OF TREE-FALL AND LANDSLIDES.
